

LEMONAID UPCYCLING - DIY PLANTER BOX

DURATION: 30 MIN · DEGREE OF DIFFICULTY: MIDDLE

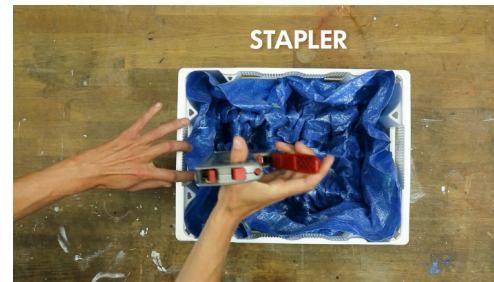


1. You need: an Ikea bag and scissors.

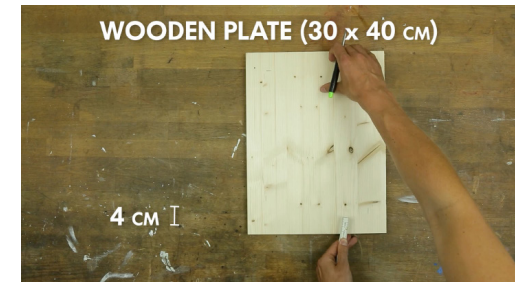


2. Cut off the bag handles.

- Equipment:**
- Ikea bag
 - Scissors
 - Lemonaid crate
 - Wooden plate (30 x 40 cm)
 - Drilling machine
 - Jigsaw
 - Stapler
 - Pieces of wood (2,5 x 3,5 cm)
 - Sandpaper
 - 8 screws
 - Organic wood oil
 - Flowers, potting soil



3. Fix the bag inside the crate with the stapler.



4. Draw a rectangle mark with 4 cm distance from the edges onto the wooden plate.



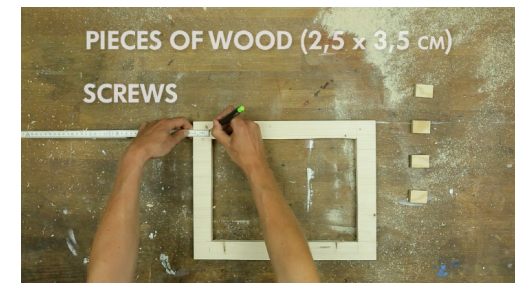
5. Drill a hole into every edge of the rectangle.



6. Cut out the rectangle.

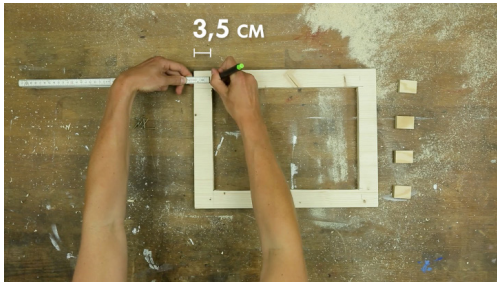


7. Sandpaper the edges.

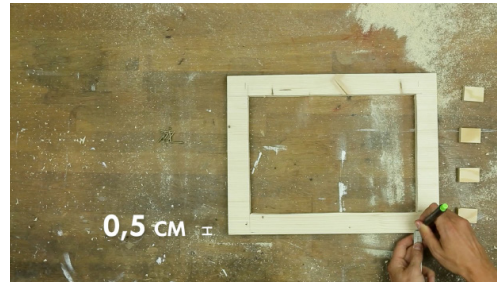


8. Get the 2,5 x 3,5 cm pieces of wood and the screws ready. →

DURATION: 30 MIN · DEGREE OF DIFFICULTY: MIDDLE



9. Draw marks 3,5 cm from the edges of the short sides of the plate.



10. And draw marks 0,5 cm from the edges of the long sides of the plate.



11. Using the marks, fix the pieces of wood with screws on the plate.



12. Treat the frame with organic wood oil on both sides.



13. Put it on the crate.



14. Just add potting soil and flowers - done!
